Sunday, May 27, 2018:



Arrive in Venezia

Fly into Venice and meet the English speaking tour manager that will be with you for the whole trip. You will have a private transfer from the airport to the hotel via water taxi. Visit San Marco Square and spend the night in a wonderful Venetian hotel.

Monday, May 28, 2018:



Venezia

Group tour: Secret Trail of Doge's Palace; This tour starts in the gold ceilinged state rooms and ends in the Piombi jail cells. You will follow the path that prisoners of the Venetian Republic took from the rooms of the Venice magistrates through the Torture Rooms directly to the prisons, the Piombi. You will also see Giacomo Casanova's cell! We will also visit St. Mark's Basilica, admire the the Bridge of Sighs, the San Marco bell tower, the Rialto Bridge and those interested can visit the Scuola San Rocco, "Tintoretto's Sistine Chapel" as well as take a Gondola ride!

Tuesday, May 29, 2018:



Bologna and Firenze

Travel from Venice to Bologna via bus. Bologna's nickname is "*La dotta, la grossa e la rossa*". While in Bologna, you'll experience what the local cuisine through a 4 hour cooking class! After the class, you'll travel to Florence via bus and spend the night in Florence.

Wednesday, May 30, 2018:



Firenze

Galleria dell'Accademia di Firenze; Spend the day at this wonderful art museum, the home of Michelangelo's famed David. It also houses other sculptures by Michelangelo and a collection of Renaissance paintings. Those interested can visit the Santa Croce Church where many great Florentines and Tuscans have their final resting place, including Michelangelo and Galileo and later admire the Uffizi Gallery.

Thursday, May 31, 2018:



Firenze

Spend the day at a wine tasting in Florence. As the capital of Tuscany, the city is known for its wines. The most famous is the Chianti Classico, but you'll also find wines like the Brunello di Montalcino, Pomino Vin Santo and other trebbiano white wines. After the wine tasting, you'll travel to Rome via bus where you will spend the night.

Friday, June 1, 2018:



Roma

On the last day of the trip experience the wonders of the Vatican with a visit to the Vatican Museums (audio-guide included). The Vatican Museums display the immense collection of works cultivated by the present and former Popes. You will see Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel and the Stanze di Raffaello decorated by Raphael. With a total of 54 galleries, it is one of the largest museums in the world. You will also be able to visit the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, the Spanish Steps, Piazza Venezia and the Altar of the Fatherland.
